Pam is a Chartered Mechanical Engineer and Fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering with broad experience in the manufacturing and engineering industries. She has worked in large companies such as GKN Sankey and East Midlands Electricity plc but also has considerable experience of owning and managing small engineering businesses. She has served on the boards of a variety of companies including Chesterfield Royal Foundation Trust Hospital, Source BioScience plc and the Rainbow Seed Fund. She is currently a Director/Trustee of several organisations including, Quest Investments Ltd, Tool & Steel Products Ltd, Sheffield Cathedral and Sheffield Assay Office.

Pam served as a Governor of Sheffield Hallam University, Chairman of the Governors of Sheffield High School and a Trustee of the City & Guilds of London Institute. She was a visiting Professor to the Department of Engineering at the University of Sheffield, who recently named the new Engineering Post Graduate building after her. She was the first woman to be elected as President of the Institution of Mechanical Engineers as well as the first woman to be elected as Master of the Company of Cutlers in Hallamshire. She has served as High Sheriff of South Yorkshire and is a Deputy Lieutenant of that County. She was awarded the OBE for services to engineering and has a number of Honorary Doctorates.
